The driver of the vehicle had not maintained adequate insurance, and the insurance carrier for our client refused to pay on our client's automobile under-insurance policy. The family came to Cohen + Feeley and after the matter was scheduled for arbitration, but prior to its commencement, the insurance company tendered the \$1.5 million policy limits.

## **Class Action Lawsuit Against Lehigh Valley College**

Recently, Cohen + Feeley filed a class action lawsuit against Lehigh Valley College (LVC), formerly Allentown Business School. The claim was filed on behalf of dozens of students and former students of LVC who were steered to student loans with the high interest rates typically associated with credit cards. The students were under the impression that the loans for which they applied were of the customary low interest rates commonly associated with student loans. The Pennsylvania Attorney General's office is also investigating the actions of LVC.
